

WARNING: Risk of fire and electrical shock. This product is to be installed by a qualified electrician only.

SIA/SRA Mounting



INSTALLATION:

1. SEPARATE COUPLER BASES FROM CAPS ,AND SECURE BASES TO CEILING WITH HARDWARE (BY OTHERS).
2. FEED AIRCRAFT CABLES THROUGH CAPS AND SCREW ONTO COUPLER BASES.
3. INSERT OTHER END OF CABLES INTO GRIPPERS ON FIXTURE.
4. SECURE CROSSBAR ONTO JUNCTION BOX WITH MOUNTING SCREWS (BY OTHERS).
5. FEED POWER CORD THROUGH CANOPY. MAKE CONNECTIONS TO REMOTE DRIVERS, OR BRANCH CIRCUIT DEPENDING ON FIXTURE CONFIGURATION.
6. SECURE CANOPY TO CROSSBAR USING COUPLER BASE. FEED AIRCRAFT CABLE THROUGH CAP, AND ATTACH TO COUPLER BASE.
7. MAKE NECESSARY HEIGHT ADJUSTMENTS, AND LEVEL THE FIXTURE USING INTERNAL AIRCRAFT GRIPPERS. TRIM EXCESS CABLE AFTER ESTABLISHING DESIRED HEIGHT.
